Sir/Madam,


In continuation of **Notification No. 104 dated 16.11.2021** and **Notification No. 119 dated 13.12.2021**, the Board would like to reiterate that all registered schools shall continue to track the progress of their students of Class X, XI & XII and guide them to appear the ensuing Board Examinations.

The HSLC and HSSLC Examinations 2022 are tentatively scheduled to be held in the month of **March 2022** provided the situation is conducive to hold offline examination and subject to the approval of the Government. The Class XI Promotion Examination 2022 will be held tentatively in the month of **April 2022** so that schools get some time to transact the syllabus and prepare the students to write their promotion examination. Moreover, with the prevailing situation, enough space is required in schools/Examination centres for holding Board Examinations of HSLC and HSSLC 2022.

As stated in the earlier notifications, schools are advised to start their regular classes for Class XI and remedial teaching and revision for Class X and XII from the **2nd week of January 2022**.

Schools are reminded to monitor the progress of their students through various modes of assessments by identifying the needs of all categories of the students.
