The subject will be introduced in Class XI from 2022 and Class XII in 2023 academic session respectively.

Therefore, all concerned Higher Secondary Schools affiliated to the Board are hereby informed that the students of Arts stream can offer Mathematics as an elective subject. As such, interested institutions are informed to introduce Mathematics as a subject of study in their respective institutions and appoint qualified teacher to teach the subject.

Further, as emphasised in the NEP 2020, all higher secondary schools are also requested to introduce more subjects, as given in the existing syllabus at higher secondary level so that students may be given more choice of subjects.
