NO.NBE-8/Ad-Misc(10)/2023-24:: It is hereby notified for information of all that the Department of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India, had launched a nation-wide campaign "Jal Shakti Abhiyan - Catch the Rain", with the tag line "Catch the rain, where it falls, when it falls" to nudge the states and all stakeholders to create Rain Water Harvesting Structures (RWHS) suitable to the climatic conditions and sub-soil strata, with people's active participation. An online course on the campaign, focusing on saving and conserving rainwater, was also launched by National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) on the DIKSHA portal during March 2023.
